

SMARTPHONE PICTURES – HOW TO TAKE, STORE, AND SHARE THEM (224)

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Your smartphone includes a camera which may make it the second-best reason for having a smartphone. This course will focus on the camera and pictures. It will cover how to take pictures, where they are typically stored, and how to share them with a friend as attachments to a text (or email). Sharing pictures using the Messaging App has become a preferred form of electronic communications. Moving your pictures to a Microsoft computer, so they will be safe, will also be covered. The Android Operating System is used in examples, but similar results can be accomplished using Apple phones and computers. A basic knowledge of your device is expected.
