The first class, 10/12, will begin at 9:30 a.m. This 30-minute portion of the class (9:30 – 10 a.m.) will be the introduction and plan for the course. All students will work on the same picture for the five weeks. The course will cover the use of watercolor materials from simple wash to direct application.

Students need to bring the following:

- (a) Kneaded eraser
- (b) Plastic Palette for watercolor - large enough to hold a minimum of 8 colors, plus at least two large areas to mix colors
- (c) One large role of cheap paper towels
- (d) Two plastic medium sized containers for water
- (e) BRUSHES: an 8, 6, and 4 ultra round watercolor brush, plus a 3/4" angular and a # 1 liner
- (f) COLORS for watercolor: Cadmium Yellow, Ultramarine Blue, Alizarin Crimson (Red), Sap Green, Violet, and Cadmium Orange
- (g) 140 pd Cold Press watercolor paper (one sheet).
- (h) 1/2" or better of foam core board or something to tape paper to
- (i) White artist tape approx. 1/2"
- (j) Mechanical pencil that holds 0.05 lead
- (k) Small spray bottle, similar to what one gets at the optometrist office.
