DRT Mission

- The Disaster Response Team helps those who have been impacted by hurricanes, tornadoes, floods, or other disastrous situations.
- We respond both locally and beyond our community to provide help.
- The Disaster Response Team's mission is:
 - "To provide a caring Christian presence in the aftermath of a disaster"

Disaster Response Team

- The DRT is open to all Christians who are over 18 and willing to serve, which includes seasonal Florida residents.
- Other Christian churches' members are welcome and able to join.
- One of the primary DRT activities is to volunteer for mission trips that provide Christian comfort, empathy, and physical help to those who have suffered the effects of hurricanes and other natural disasters.
- With reference to disaster response, the team is invited into the community through our parent organization, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR).

DRT Training

- The DRT's response starts when individuals like you have a desire to spread Christian love and witness by helping others in need.
- To prepare for work that needs to be done on a mission trip, all new members will complete a background check and attend training.
- Initial training is eight hours (often at our church, or another local church within the district).
- Refresher training is providing as needed.
- With training and support from other team members, you will be ready to assist wherever needed.
