Richard Werking will be reviewing Alan Taylor's [American Revolutions: A Continental History, 1750-1804](#), which [The New Yorker](#) has described as "A mind-opening book." Alan Taylor is the Thomas Jefferson Professor of History at the University of Virginia and has twice won the Pulitzer Prize for History.

Richard Werking is Library Director and Professor of History, Emeritus, at the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis. He earned M.A. and Ph.D. degrees in American History at the University of Wisconsin, Madison, and an M.A. in Librarianship at the University of Chicago. His career as a librarian and History professor took him to Lawrence University, Ole Miss, Trinity University (San Antonio, TX), and 20 years at Annapolis. He resides in Louisville. In February 2023, he gave two presentations at Center 4Life Learning.
